# Step 1: New Building Permit Process

- Submit New Mexico Construction Industry Division (NMCID) Building Application to The City of Sunland Park Community Development Department.
  - Home Owners wanting to submit a building application need to submit a <u>NMCID Home Owner</u>
    Application and must have it notarized.
- Submit City of Sunland Park Building Permit Application
- Submit 2 sets of professional draft drawings
  - o Foundation and Truss plans shall have New Mexico Engineer Seals with address matching to plans
  - o Submit CRRUA Application for new services
  - No hand drawings will be accepted
  - o If multiple applications are submitted, ensure that each set of plans are complete and submitted individually with all required documents for review.

# Step 2: Review: Land Use

- Allow 5-15 days for The City of Sunland Park Building Officials to review, process and sign off on the city's Land Review portion of the NMCID Building Application
- City Administrative Assistant shall contact the applicant by phone or email to provide instructions for pick-up and payment.

### Step 3: Payment for Land Use Review

- Payment can be made online or in person at City of Sunland Park City Hall, have permit number ready

### Step 4: Pick-up

Pick-up signed NMCID Building Application and 2 sets of plans from Community Development

#### Step 5: Submit NMCID Building Application to NMCID Regional Office

- Take NMCID Building Application with 2 sets of plans to NMCID Office in Las Cruces, NM

- Registered Accela contractors may upload NMCID application through Accela Permitting System
