

## Monte Cristo Blvd./Gila Drive Bid Project Update



- Phase I of Safety Improvements along Riverside Elementary School
- Four (4) bidders, but only three (3) responsive
- Responsive Low Bid is Nine Degrees
- Project Notice of Award issued in June and anticipated for completion before school starts this fall

The contractors submitted their RFQ proposals for the above-referenced project via email, and both Claudia Carrillo and I received them on May 8, 2025, at 12:00 PM local time.

A total of four (4) proposals were received, as detailed in the table below. However, one proposal was deemed non-responsive due to non-compliance with the requested requirements.


# Infrastructure Projects Update
